2 INTENDED USE

Incorrect use of the solenoid valve Type 2513 can be dangerous to people, nearby equipment and the environment.




Fig. 1: Markings on device socket

9 INSTALLATION



WARNING!

Risk of injury from improper montage.

- Installation may be carried out by authorised technicians only and with the appropriate tools.

Before loosening the lines and valves, turn off the pressure and vent the lines.

Use undamaged device sockets only.




Fig. 2: Installing the cable plug

9.1 Electrical installation
